All Scholarships will be paid to the Educational Institution. Scholarship awards are awarded each year and the scholarship amount is determined by the CRMC Foundation Board of Directors and the Scholarship Committee.

Best Family Scholarship

This scholarship was established by the children of Jerry and Norma Best. The intent of the scholarship is to provide financial assistance to students that have been accepted into a degreed medical field program (for example, but not limited to: paramedic, lab, x-ray, nursing, medicine, etc).

1. This scholarship may be renewed subsequent years.
2. Applicants must be enrolled in a degreed medical program.
3. Applicants must submit the CRMC Foundation Scholarship Application and a typed, personal reflective essay. This essay must be at least 500 words. The essay should speak to the topic of "Why you have decided to become a healthcare worker, what life experiences have guided that decision and what challenges you have overcome to further your education." A formal interview may be requested by the committee members.
4. Grade and GPA Transcript information should be submitted with the application.

John & Edna Cape Scholarship

This scholarship was established by the John K. and Edna M. Cape Trust. The intent of the scholarship is to offer financial assistance to a student who has a desire to become a Dietitian.

1. Applicant must be a junior or senior undergraduate student participating in an approved dietary study program or a graduate student pursuing certification as a Dietitian.
2. Undergraduate juniors/seniors may receive up to \$5,000 per year. Graduate students may receive up to \$10,000 per year.
3. Applicants must submit the CRMC Foundation Scholarship Application, Federal Application for Student Financial Aid, and official college transcripts.
4. Recipients must maintain a minimum GPA of 3.2
5. Applicants may be required to participate in an interview.

Han Family Scholarship

This scholarship was established by the children of Dr. and Mrs. Chan Han, longtime Coffeyville pediatrician. The intent of the scholarship is to provide financial assistance to employees of CRMC who are continuing their education in a medical field/program. (paramedic, lab, x-ray, nursing, medicine, etc).

1. Open to employees of Coffeyville Regional Medical Center or those who express a serious interest in returning to CRMC to serve the local community.
2. Applicants must be enrolled in accredited medical program.
3. Applicants must submit the CRMC Foundation Scholarship Application and a typed, personal reflective essay on why they chose to pursue a career in healthcare. This essay must be at least 500 words. A formal interview may be requested by the committee members.
4. Grade and GPA Transcript information should be submitted with the application.
