

Rules for the Golf Ball Drop at the Bill Read Golf Classic

- 1. The Golf Ball Drop is presented at the Bill Read Golf Classic by Coffeyville Regional Medical Center Foundation for the benefit of the Foundation in accordance with the Internal Revenue Service Code.
- 2. Golf balls will be dropped onto the golf ball field at the conclusion of the golf tournament on **Saturday**, **October 1**, **2022**. At the direction of Presenter, all balls may be dropped from a man lift, or crane. If for any reason beyond the control of the Presenter such as weather conditions, the Presenter determines not to release drop the balls or complete the event, the event will be postponed to a future date.
- 3. The entry portion of each purchase form must be completely filled out and delivered to Presenter, online registered, or mailed to Presenter, and actually received by Presenter prior to the event to be eligible to win any prize. Entrants assume the risk of non-delivery of entries to Presenter or any authorized representative of Presenter.
- 4. A number will be written on each ball which corresponds to the number on its purchase form. \$500 will be awarded to the person whose name appears on its purchase form. Prizes will be awarded to the person whose name appears on the purchase form corresponding to the ball number in the hole, or closest to it after dropping.
- 5. All balls entered will be provided by the Presenter and shall remain the property of the Presenter.
- 6. All prize winners will be notified by telephone. Winners need not be present to win. If any winner does not claim his or her prize from the Presenter within 30 days after written notification of winning, the presenter may select a substitute winner through a random drawing of golf ball drop forms.
- 7. Entry constitutes permission to Presenter to use your name, voice, statements, image and likeness for purposes of advertising and trade, in any medium, without further compensation or notice, unless prohibited by law.
