#### Geeta Sandhu Women's Health Unit

The Women's Health Unit allows patients to labor, deliver and recover in the same room. Patients also have whirlpool tubs available to use during labor to help relieve their pain. A dedicated surgical suite is available in the Geeta Sandhu Women's Health Unit for planned or emergency cesarean sections.

The medical staff, here at CRMC, strives to develop a personal relationship with each patient during their time together. The staff are experienced in calming patients and assisting them through the joys and trials of labor and delivery.

Expectant mothers are able to move down the hall for their surgery and then return to their room. "The Women's Health Unit staff puts their patients first," said Dr. Dara Gibson. "The staff care about their patient's pain and try to make them comfortable. The whirlpool tubs offer great heat therapy for relaxing muscles during labor and our anesthesia team is readily

available for epidurals."

Security is of the utmost importance and all infants have security bracelets that match their parents. Infants also receive a security ankle bracelet shortly after birth that will sound an alarm if the baby were removed from the locked department. New mothers can expect support and training prior to and after the birth of their child.

CRMC offers free childbirth education classes to help parents prepare for the birth of their child. The class includes education on the stages of labor, breastfeeding, postpartum, infant care and also includes a tour of the Women's Health Unit.

Expectant mothers may also receive a 3D/4D ultrasound in the recently renovated OB Ultrasound room. The room was designed with seating for family members to view the ultrasound live or allow family to see pictures of the baby on a 50" flat screen TV in an adjacent room.

CRMC recognizes that fathers are an important part of the delivery process! That's why each room has a sofa sleeper for their comfort.


## **Services to Educate and Support New Moms**Expectant parents can also take advantage of a variety

Expectant parents can also take advantage of a variety of other services:

- Childbirth education These classes prepare the mother and father (or other support person) emotionally, physically and intellectually for active participation in the birthing process. The course includes relaxation exercises, what to expect during labor and delivery, breathing and pushing techniques and care after birth, including breastfeeding. Childbirth Education is free to women delivering at CRMC.
- High Five for Mom and Baby Program CRMC participates in this program, provided by the United Methodist Health Ministry Fund, at no charge to Kansas hospitals that qualify. The program is based on five crucial steps necessary for a successful breastfeeding experience.
- Certified Lactation Consultants, two registered nurses are available on the unit to help any mother with questions and concerns about breastfeeding.
- 3D and 4D Ultrasound "Will I have a boy or girl?" CRMC offers a fetal sex ultrasound at around 18-22 weeks of pregnancy. The fetal sex ultrasound does not require a doctor's order, but there is a fee for this service.
- Maternal & Infant Services (M&I) This clinic provides comprehensive prenatal care and follow-up for mother and infant for up to one year post delivery. The M&I clinic is located at the CRMC Medical Group in Independence and is offered every Wednesday from 9:00am 4:00pm. Financial assistance and a nutritionist are available to expectant mothers during their visits. Patients will see Judy Carpenter, APRN for the majority of their appointments, and then will be provided a CRMC Medical Group OB/GYN physician for the last four weeks of pregnancy. Post-op care is provided, as well.
- Wee Care Baby Support CRMC helps new mothers in the adjustment period of parenting with all its new responsibilities. We understand many questions and fears may arise in the first weeks and months when a new little one joins the family. Mothers are encouraged to come with baby to the Geeta Sandhu Women's Health Services unit to receive support and encouragement.

## Breast Health Nurse Navigator



A Breast Health Nurse Navigator is a Registered Nurse who is specifically trained and educated to help breast cancer patients "navigate" the steps involved in seeking treatment and care in the ever-complex health care system.

She can answer your questions and explain medical procedures, and she can provide comfort, compassion and emotional support to you and your family. The Breast Health Nurse Navigator program provides for a speedier process beneficial to the patient when time is critical.

"As the Breast Health Nurse Navigator, if needed, I am able to refer those patients to an oncologist, cancer center or general surgeon of their choosing. If they choose to continue their care at CRMC, I am able to follow up with them more closely. These dual roles allow me to be with the patient every step of the way and help them know they have someone by their side; I try to make a scary situation easier to handle."

Christy is located in the Medical Imaging Department. She is available to assist all breast cancer patients and their families through diagnosis, surgery and post-surgery. She can answer questions and inform patients on what to expect all while providing emotional support throughout the process.

#### The Genius™ 3D

The Genius 3D Mammography exam allows doctors to examine your breast tissue layer by layer. So, instead of viewing all of the complexities of your breast tissue in a flat image, as with conventional 2D mammography, fine details are more visible and no longer hidden by the tissue above or below. The Genius exam consists of a 2D and 3D™ image set, where the 2D image can be either an acquired 2D image or a 2D image generated from the 3D™ image set.

More than 200 clinical studies have shown that by using this technology, doctors are able to screen for breast cancer with greater accuracy — which means better breast cancer detection and a reduced chance of being called back for additional screenings.




# living in Coffeyville, Kansas
